
CARICATURE FLAWS






You want judgmental? *Here's judgmental!*







We could be traveling on Amtrak!







We might even get bigger rooms!


Crappe, you're a classic example of what happens when a school hands out too many athletic scholarships!

Nah! She just threw out her back trying to clean her butt with her tongue!




This school is a mess! Ninky Outsize has been kidnapped! There are dead roosters all over the place! And Haggard says he wants to be "more than friends!"

This is the most deadly situation in the history of this bathroom. Or at least since the infamous bratwurst, sauerkraut and beans banquet of 1768!


Ugh! This place is filled with rubble, cobwebs, rat skulls and a huge empty snakeskin!

Wow! That was close! I can't believe one of our own professors tried to betray us!


Pockmark's lucky! He's the only person who won't notice that the "final showdown in the basement maze" ending we're doing now is a straight ripoff from the first book!

Harry Plodder, you've done it! You beat Druckermort single-handedly! You're a hero!


