Flags at Spy Headquarters are flying at half-mast due to the recent death of "Spy Vs. Spy" creator Antonio Prohias. Antonio, who retired about 10 years ago, died in Florida on February 24th. The strip has run and will continue to run thanks to the talents of many MAD contributors, including Duck Edwing, Bob Clarke, George Woodbridge, Dave Manak and, most recently, Peter Kuper. The following are a sampling of the many kind letters we received from saddened readers:



The envelope Tom Anderson's letter arrived in was also a tribute to Prohias.

"Spy Vs. Spy" was the first thing I read in MAD Magazine. My father was a big fan of MAD and had a pile of them in his closet. When my brother and I discovered them, back around 1963, I was only three years old. Since I couldn't read at the time, I looked for the features without words. Antonio Prohias' and Sergio Aragones' art always made the magazine worth thumbing through. As I got older, I would go back and read the same issues and found more and more to enjoy as I learned about the world.

In 1975, I was 15, and my family took a trip cross-country from California to New York. While in New York City, my brother Bob and I begged our parents to let us visit the offices of MAD Magazine. My father agreed, and circled the block for a half hour while we ran up to the 13th floor of the Madison Avenue offices. When we arrived, the secretary asked if we had an appointment. Oh no! We had come so close and now it looked like we wouldn't get to see anything. We explained we had come all the way from California and this was our only chance to visit. Just then, the door opened, and MAD Editor Al Feldstein smiled and welcomed us inside. Wow, we're in! As we walked down the art-covered hall to the large layout/art room, we saw Leonard Brenner pasting type down on some art. Al had given each of us a "cheap crummy souvenir" — a mini poster of the whole staff, which we excitedly got everyone there to autograph for us.

I remember him fondly and with admiration. He once took the time for me, making me very happy, and now I take the time to let others know what a truly kind and talented man Antonio Prohias was.



All of which got us to wondering - what if Bill Clinton had been Chief Executive in other times past? Well, history buffs, wonder no more as MAD careers through the eons of time to present...

ABRAHAM CLINTON -1865

PRESIDENT DENIES HIDING BEHIND FIRST LADY AT FORD'S THEATER

WASHINGTON - April 17. President Clinton today repudiated charges that he deliberately ducked behind First Lady Mary Todd Rodham Clinton to avoid being shot by John Wilkes Booth at Ford's Theater three days ago.

"It just didn't happen that way," Clinton told reporters. "When Booth shouted 'Sic semper tyrannis' I thought he said, 'It takes a village' and wanted to meet the author." (*It Takes a Village* is the title of the late First Lady's most recent, and apparently last, book.) "Rather than dwell on what happened, I think the First Lady's wishes would be to continue healing the nation's wounds after the Civil War through a series of tax cuts targeted to aid the middle class."

Clinton is also expected to use the fact that Booth used a flintlock pistol to press Congress for quick passage of the Brady Bill, a gun-control measure named for Civil War photographer Matthew Brady, who took countless photographs of military men holding flintlocks.

Clinton's explanation contradicted statements by several eyewitnesses, who said he intentionally used his wife as a shield when he saw Booth's gun. "They don't call him 'Dishonest Abe' for nothing," said one observer. The controversy has led to the appointment of a special prosecutor, Ezekiel Starr. Starr's Grand Jury is expected to hear testimony today from Vernon Jordan, a recently freed slave and the President's friend, who is expected to back the President's explanation of the events leading to the First Lady's shooting.

"With the first lady out of the way, Clinton's now a single man and can philosopher right out in the open," said a Washington insider. "Not that it made any difference before."

Despite the seriousness of the charges, Clinton's overall popularity remains astonishingly high. The latest poll shows that 81% of the people consider him an "excellent" President. No southern states were included in the poll, however.

CLINTON DENIES INVOLVEMENT IN LOUISIANA-GATE SCANDAL

WASHINGTON - May 30. President Clinton today claimed innocence regarding shady land dealings in the newly acquired Louisiana Territory. Despite the denials, special prosecutor Alexander Hamilton Starr vowed to carry on his investigation of White House involvement.

According to sources close to the probe, documents exist describing a deal between the President and explorers Meriwether Lewis McDougal and William Clark McDougal. The three men are accused of secretly acquiring thousands of acres of the choice wilderness recently purchased from France to be sold at a profit to independent land developers. The developers allegedly contributed \$100,000 to a so-called "flush fund" used by

Clinton to install experimental indoor plumbing in his Monticello mansion.

"This is just a land speculation deal that I lost money on," said Clinton. "Besides, I had nothing to do with it. My wife put this deal together." Investigators consider this statement highly suspect, as women aren't allowed to own real estate. Starr is also looking into a possible connection between the land deal and the recent mysterious dueling death of Vincent Foster, the First lady's law associate.

Despite the scandal, the President's popularity has reached an all-time high, the latest polls showing that 81% of the American people give him an "excellent" on-the-job rating.

PRESIDENT HOLDS U.S. ARMY BLAMELESS AT WOUNDED KNEE MASSACRE IN SOUTH DAKOTA

Cites Faulty Peace Pipe Process

WASHINGTON - Dec 29. President Clinton refused to condemn the Army in the massacre killing of between 150 and 370 Indian men, women and children at Wounded Knee, South Dakota today.

"It's true that before troops opened fire, our generals smoked the peace pipe with tribal elders," he explained. "But under my order, none of our officers inhaled! This meant the Army wasn't required to follow any treaties, and they started shooting. Besides, our intelligence reports indicated the savages were manufacturing arrows, tomahawks and other weapons of mass destruction. It left us no alternative."

Many in Washington are critical of Clinton's ordering troops into action when he himself avoided serving in the cavalry by spending a year at Oxford University in England. Still, an unrepentant Clinton commented, "When I was elected, I pledged to end concern for the Indian's welfare as we know it, and I've fulfilled that promise. Now, our nation can get on with the business of building a bridge to the 20th century."

The public seems to be siding with the President, as recent polls indicate 81% of the population gives him an "excellent" rating as Commander-In-Chief. None of the polls were taken on Indian reservations.

FRANKLIN DELANO CLINTON - 1941

PRESIDENT SAYS SLOW RESPONSE TO PEARL HARBOR ATTACK HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH ASIAN CONTRIBUTIONS

WASHINGTON - Dec. 14. Addressing a joint session of Congress last night, President Clinton called for an all-out declaration to consider how to best respond to last week's unprovoked attack on Pearl Harbor by the Japanese, which resulted in the sinking of over 20 naval vessels and the deaths of approximately 3,000 American military personnel.

Critics immediately charged that the President's slow reaction is directly related to the millions of dollars of Asian campaign contributions he received during the last election.

In referring to the attack, not the one on Pearl Harbor, but the one on his character, Clinton began his remarks to Congress with "December 7th, 1941 - A day which will live in infamy, because

of baseless charges made against me as part of a vast right-wing conspiracy."

Clinton went on to say, "We have to learn the reasons why our respected Asian friends launched their sneak attack before we can respond appropriately, and to that end I have sent Vice President Gore to attend a Buddhist Temple fundraiser, er, fact-finding conference."

Despite the seeming lack of decisive leadership, President Clinton's popularity rating is still at an all-time high. The rating began rising when he adopted a puppy named Fala last month. Following the President's address to Congress, freshman Kansas Senator Robert Dole was heard exclaiming, "Where's the outrage, where's the outrage?"
