And then, and only then, do we give an opinion off the tops of our heads!

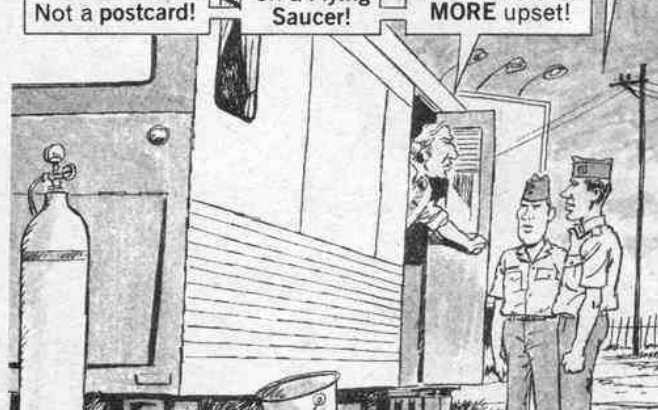

Oh, let him go on!

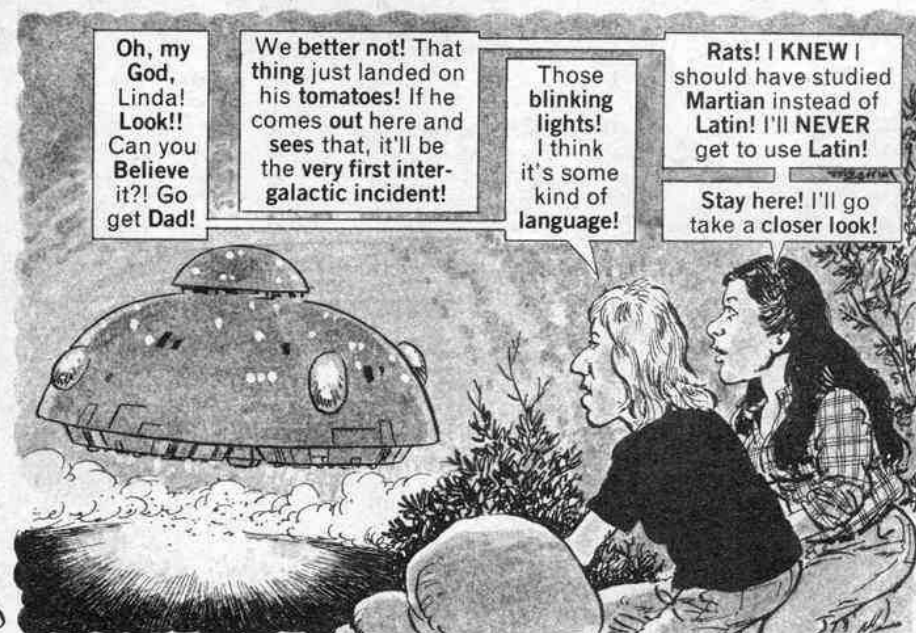

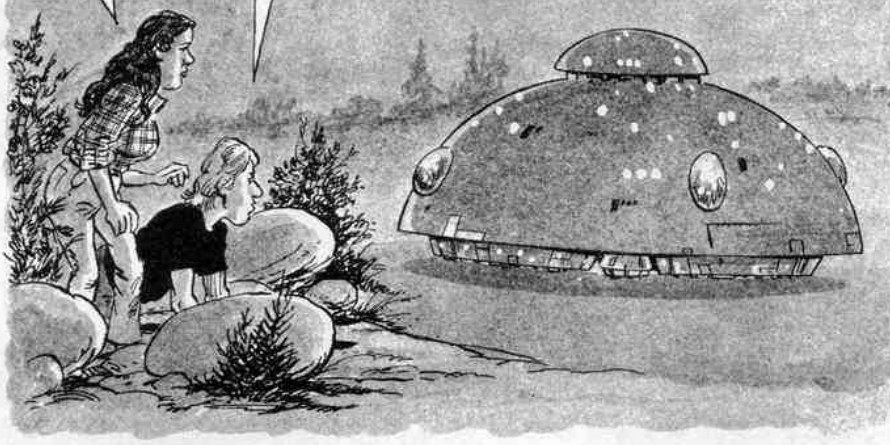
Y'know... I think I'm beginning to understand their code! They're saying, "We'll have a large pizza with everything on it... to go!"

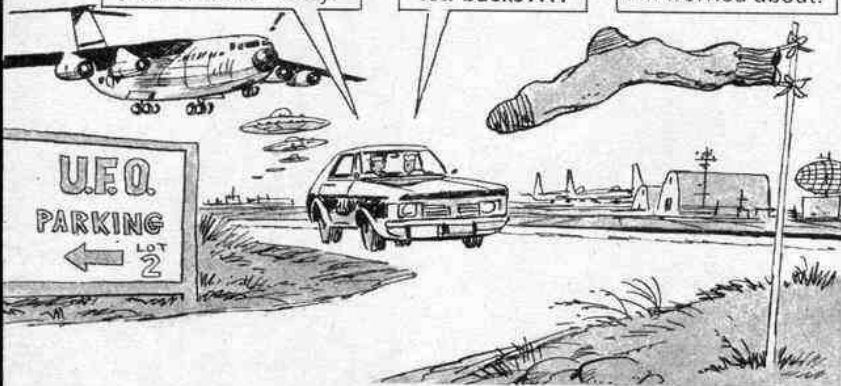
What's the big deal, Captain? If the kid's pictures **ARE** fake, you're only out a few bucks...!
